On Friday, November 17 (7:00 p.m.), the Stansberry Children's Home (USA) Board of Directors in conjunction with Living Love Ministries, will host a special event for Solomon and Eunice Mwangi, former missionary administrators of the Stansberry Children's Home, Santa Cruz, Bolivia.

Solomon and Eunice will be sharing their vision of ministry to the homeless children of Kenya upon their return to their homeland. This gathering will take place at the Smithville Brethren Church (on Main Street in Smithville).

In 1996, shortly after graduating from the University of Nairobi, Solomon felt a call to minister to the many homeless children so prevalent on the streets of Nairobi and other urban areas of Kenya. Solomon heard the Lord's command to: "Defend the cause of the weak and the fatherless; maintain the rights of the poor and oppressed. Rescue the weak and needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked." (Psalm 82:3-4) Solomon and Eunice have felt a call from God to respond to the needs of some of the millions of children orphaned and exposed to the HIV/AIDS pandemic in their homeland. Together with Living Love Ministries, Solomon and Eunice seek to establish a network of children's homes, day care centers and educational facilities where these children will be nurtured, loved and provided the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Mwangi's will be returning to Kenya at the end of this year after taking time in Pennsylvania and Ohio to meet with persons who would share their vision and help them secure property for the first children's home in the city of Elodoret. The evening gathering will include fellowship, dessert and a presentation by the Mwangi's.
